## JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Town of Clarkdale, Arizona (Pop. 4,100) seeks a community-oriented, progressive Police Officer who is ready to be fully involved in the special quality of life of a small town.

Located in central Arizona, Clarkdale is a charming, historic town, on the banks of the Verde River and at the base of Mingus Mountain. Ideally situated above the heat of the desert and below the cold of Arizona's high country, Clarkdale enjoys a moderate year-round climate with an elevation of 3,500 feet. With easy access to surrounding National Forest lands, numerous State Parks, National Monuments, the red rocks of Sedona and numerous historic and archaeological sites, residents are surrounded by natural, scenic beauty and recreational opportunities. Notably, the Verde Valley was recently named one of the Top 10 Places to Visit in the U.S. by both CNN and the Lonely Planet (worldwide travel advisor).



Clarkdale operates under a Council-Manager form of government, with a reputation as a stable local government operating with a high degree of professionalism and efficiency. Here we take pride in the productive working relationships between the Council, staff and community. The Town has 36 full-time employees, with 8.5 full time staff in the Police Department.

Candidates for this position who possess Police Certification from an accredited Police academy or equivalent certification from a college or military academy will be given priority consideration.

Characteristics of this position cover a wide range of duties including patrol, traffic enforcement, and investigations of all types such as: theft, burglary, sex offense, death, fraud, etc.



The Clarkdale Police Department has worked to foster and uphold a positive presence within the community. To that end, this position is key in promoting active involvement and participation in Town and police-sponsored events, establishing and maintaining strong relationships with businesses, schools, the Native American

community, religious institutions, community service organizations and other groups, and frequent and wide-ranging one-to-one contacts.

- Pass AZPOST medical examination,
- Pass psychological examination.
