Unacceptable Items*

Anything that is pressurized or can be pressurized. This includes:
Propane tanks, whether filled or not.
Fire extinguishers, whether filled or not
Any other gas tanks, whether filled or not.
Pressurized cans of anything, whether filled or not.
Gasoline or anything with gasoline in it
Anything explosive - This includes:
 A. Ammunition
 B. Flares
Firearms
Paint
Chemicals of any kind
Medical supplies with biological hazard, including waste papers, towels, needles, and some small pieces of medical hardware.
Light bulbs
Items containing mercury
Alkaline batteries
Radioactive items
Smoke detectors
Any item containing Polychlorinated Biphenyl (PCBs). This includes:
 A: Transformers and capacitors.
 B: Florescent Light Ballasts.
