ART IN PUBLIC PLACES

ART IN PUBLIC PLACES is a program concept focusing on any art that is exhibited in a public space including publicly accessible buildings. The Town of Clarkdale supports and wishes to encourage the exhibition of art throughout its public buildings. This application is specifically for artwork exhibits within programming capabilities of, and to be located in, the Clark Memorial Library located at 39 N. Ninth Street, Clarkdale, AZ 86324.

To this end, the CLARK MEMORIAL LIBRARY will provide:

- Casual exhibit space within the library for a specified time period,
- Marketing and publicity for an exhibit,
- Network opportunities for artist exposure,
- Program coordinators to assist with program oversight, exhibit arrangements, installation and removal.

Exhibition Guidelines:

- All exhibits are free and open to the public during LIBRARY's normal hours of operation.
- The ARTIST will provide artwork that is ready to professionally display and/or ready-to-hang – framed or canvas wrapped on the frame.
- The ARTIST will provide labels for each piece of artwork which include ARTIST's name, title of work, and type of medium.
- No pricing information can be displayed in the LIBRARY.
- LIBRARY use of the display areas takes precedence over any other use and the LIBRARY reserves the right, without notice, to cancel the use of the display area by exhibits if Community Services Supervisor determines that the display space is needed for LIBRARY purposes.
- The LIBRARY reserves the right to refuse display space to exhibits that, in its opinion, do not further the Vision and Guiding Principles of the Town of Clarkdale, or the mission and philosophy of the LIBRARY, or that do not support the selected theme or program for the month.

The ARTIST will submit a completed Artist Application form along with three photographs of work to be exhibited, email submissions preferred. The ARTIST may be requested to bring artwork to view in person. If selected to exhibit as part of the Clark Memorial Library programming, the ARTIST will be expected to leave work in place for the duration of the exhibit, however, artwork may be rotated as necessary.

If an artist's application is selected and approved, an Art in Public Places Agreement must be completed in order to define the exhibition guidelines as well as the dates of the exhibit. In addition, an inventory sheet must be completed in order to record the art pieces exhibited and the artwork value.
