Roundabout Clarkdale

A series of wayfinding signs will soon be appearing along SR 89A and Broadway Road in Clarkdale.

These wayfinding signs are designed to help create a sense of place and help direct people to Clarkdale businesses.

The design of the signs was done by the Community & Economic Development Department. The signs will include the header, which reflects a common roofline used in several signs and the historical markers in the Central Business area. The signs will also include directional information to Town amenities. Each sign will have space for the advertising of local businesses.

Funding for the signs is through a public/private partnership with local business owners and the Town of Clarkdale. Signs were awarded through a lottery process open to Clarkdale businesses with a store front in Town.

The first sign will be constructed on SR 89A on the way to Jerome and should be in place by late spring.

Candidate Nomination Packets Available

In Arizona, persons are nominated to run for public office in the Primary Election by a petition procedure for nomination. This process allows any qualified voter within the Town boundaries of Clarkdale the opportunity of seeking public office. The nomination paper is a formal notification to the Town Clerk that the individual intends to seek public office.

Candidate Nomination Packets are available Monday through Thursday between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:30 PM and Friday between 8:00 AM and Noon at the Town Hall located at 39 N. Ninth Street, Clarkdale. Candidates must file a Political Committee Statement of Organization or a \$500 Threshold Exemption Statement with the Town Clerk before receiving or expending money, circulating Nomination Petitions, or distributing campaign literature. In order to be on the ballot, completed packets must be filed with the Town Clerk between May 2, 2016 and June 1, 2016.

There are two seats with four year terms for Councilmember and one seat with a four year term for Mayor on the August 30, 2016 ballot. A candidate is declared elected to office in the Primary Election if that candidate receives a majority of all votes (ballots) cast. A canvass of the August 30, 2016 election results will determine if the November 8, 2016 General Election for local candidates is required.
