


P.O.P. Police Outreach Program

During National Night Out, the Clarkdale Police Department unveiled a new neighborhood program: the Police Outreach Program (P.O.P.). This program brings officers and residents together to build safer communities. Officers are assigned to particular neighborhoods and areas which gives citizens someone they can contact directly when concerns surface that don't necessitate immediate police response. In addition, it is designed to enlist the active participation of citizens to reduce crime by reporting suspicious activity to police and improve the quality of life in their neighborhoods. This program solidifies the partnership between law enforcement and the community they serve. The officers serve the following areas:

- Officer Johnston:** Blackhills/Haskell Springs/Crossroads area
- Officer Steele:** Lanny/Foothills/Bitter Creek area
- Officer Guth:** Mountain Gate/Centerville/Mingus Shadows/Upper Town
- Officer Kline:** Bent River/Palisades/Lower Town/Patio Park area

Set in the middle of beautiful Centennial Plaza, the legacy brick square recognizes individuals and groups who have made an important contribution to the Town. Several bricks honor family members of Clarkdale residents. There are even bricks that pay tribute to the Verde River.

Upper Town Water Main Replacement Project (UTWMRP)

The Town of Clarkdale Utilities Department has scheduled a meeting on **September 6, 2016 at the Gazebo in the Main Street Park at 6:30 pm** to meet with the residents and business owners in Upper Town. The purpose of this meeting is to provide information and to discuss the upcoming Upper Town water main replacement project. Topics to be discussed will include project phases, project scheduling, and anticipated impacts to area residents. A question and answer (Q&A) period will follow.



The work in Upper Town includes replacing approximately 13,000 linear feet of aged (90+ years old) steel water mains with new C-900 PVC mains. New service connections will be run from the new C-900 mains to the existing meter boxes. The project is expected to take ten (10) months to complete and will be done in phases concentrating work and construction impacts to one area before moving construction activities to another area or phase.

Additional public meetings will be held for each phase of the project. Residents and businesses with questions about the project, even if not living or located in the project phase being discussed, are encouraged to attend any of the public meetings for this project.



Please bring your own chairs for the meeting in the Park, and in case of rain the meeting will be moved to the Men's Lounge in the Town Hall Complex.
