The trick-or-treating route includes: <u>Main Street</u>, <u>1st North Street</u> and <u>1st South Street</u> in upper Clarkdale. Remember these streets will be closed and blocked from vehicular access 4:30 p.m. - 7:15 p.m. and will not be accessible. Please do not park on these streets - parking is available at Town Hall and Clarkdale-Jerome School.

Remember to bring a flashlight as this will aid you while travelling through the dark areas as well as with the bumps and dips in the streets and sidewalks.
