CLARKDALE HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND MUSEUM

THE FAMILY AT RATTLESNAKE HILL

One of the earliest pioneer families in the Upper Verde Valley arrived here in the late 1880's. W. A. (Will) Jordan left Maine for Arizona Territory in November 1880 and found his way to Middle Verde to farm with his cousin Ev. Will married Annie Bristow in 1889 and their first home was located on Rattlesnake Hill, directly across from the copper smelter in Clarkdale. They were the parents of nine children. CHSM has recently created a new exhibit featuring personal photos, postcards, report cards, school projects and even a side saddle belonging to daughters Stella, Mary, and Alice. In 1911, Will sold his homestead, buildings and equipment to William A. Clark, the founder of Clarkdale, and continued on as superintendent of the farms. He resigned two years later when he discovered the bookkeeper had defrauded the whole farming operation. In the early 1920's, after winning one of the first air pollution lawsuits in US history, Will and his sons Walter and George relocated to Sedona, where they started new orchards.

CLARKDALE – BROADWAY/MAIN INTERSECTION PROJECT

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is administering an intersection improvement project on behalf of the Town of Clarkdale (see project map). Work will take place within the town's right of way (ROW). During construction, occasional pedestrian and traffic restrictions can be expected. Through traffic will be accommodated at all times, although delays can be expected. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Construction on this project includes the following:

- Reconstruct intersection at Broadway Road and Main Street.
- Construct new sidewalk within project limits.
- Install new ADA-compliant pedestrian walkways and ramps.
- Install new lighting, signing and striping.
- Install shade trees.

**No weekend or holiday construction is anticipated.
Construction is scheduled for completion by late April, 2017.**
