The following restrictions apply:

Effective June 1st, 2017 until rescinded

- »Open fires, fire pits, and campfires are prohibited.
- »Cooking on propane grills and use of an UL listed, natural gas or propane flame producing heating/warming appliances that can be turned on/off and are located at least 10 ft. from combustible materials is permitted.
- »Charcoal barbeque grills are prohibited in Town parks, public areas, and at the lower TAPCO and Tuzigoot river access points. Charcoal barbeque grills are allowed at private residences if covered.
- »Smoking in Town parks is prohibited. Smoking at the lower TAPCO and Tuzigoot river access points is only permitted inside enclosed private vehicles during fire ban.
- »No burn permits will be issued, and existing burn permits are hereby suspended.
- »The discharge/use of any kind of fireworks/incendiary devices is prohibited, unless specifically permitted by the Fire Marshal and/or Fire Chief.
- »The outdoor use of welding equipment, grinders, and chainsaws is prohibited. Variances for commercial use of spark producing devices can be requested from the Fire Marshal and/or Fire Chief.

4TH OF JULY KIDS' PARADE

The 2017 4th of July Kids' Parade starts at 9 a.m. and begins at the Clarkdale-Jerome School and continues down Main Street through the business district. This is a great opportunity for the youth in our community to display their patriotism.

Those interested in participating must register at 8:15 a.m. with a parent/legal guardian at the Clarkdale-Jerome School. There is no pre-registration prior to the day of the event.

All participants under the age of eighteen (18) years must have a Waiver of Liability signed by the parent/legal guardian of the minor. Signatures will not be accepted from any other family member nor a family friend. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS.

PARADE RULES:

1. Parade entrants limited to children sixteen (16) years and under.
2. Children ages six (6) years and under must be accompanied by one (1) adult or another child at least thirteen (13) years of age.
3. Pets: Entries with animals are limited to household pets only, weighing no more than 50 lbs. No hooved animals allowed. Entries with dogs must have proof of a current license. All pets must be on leashes and must be held by someone strong enough to manage them. All pets participating in the parade must be kept under control at all times. Participant is responsible for pet clean-up.
4. A Waiver of Liability form for EACH participant under the age of eighteen (18) years MUST be completed and signed by a parent/legal guardian of minor to participate in the parade.
5. Helmets and safety gear are strongly recommended for children riding bicycles, skateboards, and scooters.
6. No commercial entries allowed.
7. No gas powered vehicles allowed.
8. Candy & giveaways must be handed out to observers, not thrown.
9. Participants are limited to win one (1) prize and cannot win in more than one (1) category.
