## Monsoon Safety

Monsoon season is here!

Here are some tips to ensure your safety during storms.

### #1. Plan Ahead

The best way to avoid lightning, flash floods, and other dangerous conditions is by not being in danger in the first place. Keep an eye on the skies, and be aware of weather forecasts.

### #2. Turn Around, Don't Drown

Avoid low water crossings and do not attempt to cross flowing streams. Driving around barricades is not only dangerous, it is illegal. Wait it out, or find a safer route.

### #3. When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors

No place outside is safe from lightning. Go inside a building, or a fully enclosed metal-topped vehicle.

### #4. Pull Aside, Stay Alive

Dust storms, or haboobs, are common during the early part of monsoon season, but can occur at any time. Pull off the road as far as you safely can, and stay where you are until the storm passes.

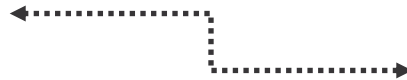
## Clarkdale Utilities On-Call System 24-Hour A Day Reporting

Clarkdale residents have a 24-hour on-call operator available to take reports of any water or sewer emergencies, leaks or issues. The Town of Clarkdale Utilities Department urges all residents to utilize this system for reporting water and sewer issues.

The on-call system is the fastest way to get a response, and ensures that our Utilities staff is notified of the problem in a timely manner! Phone calls to other numbers, emails or messages on social media will delay our response, and in some cases, those delays could be significant!

Help us to respond to water and/or sewer issues and emergencies in a timely fashion by contacting our on-call system phone, thereby minimizing water service outages or sewer overflows.
