## DEMAND REDUCTION STRATEGIES TO BE LIFTED

On 7/31/2017 the Town of Clarkdale moved into Demand Reduction Strategy II "Water Alert" after a severe lightning storm on July 23, 2017, damaging the variable frequency drive equipment at the Mountain Gate Well. The repairs have been completed at the Mountain Gate Well and the well is operating normally.

All "Demand Reductions" (Strategy I and II), will be lifted as of **October 1, 2017**. Thank you for your conservation efforts and cooperation in following Strategy II "Water Alert" to ensure adequate water supply to all of Clarkdale.

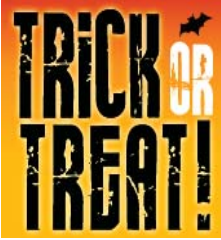

## SAFE TRICK-OR-TREATING IN UPPER CLARKDALE

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31<sup>ST</sup>

5 P.M. – 7 P.M.

The trick-or-treating route includes: Main Street, 1st North Street and 1st South Street in upper Clarkdale. Remember these streets will be closed and blocked from vehicular access 4:30 p.m. - 7:15 p.m. and will not be accessible. Please do not park on these streets - parking is available at Town Hall and Clarkdale-Jerome School.

Remember to bring a flashlight as this will aid you while traveling through the dark areas as well as with the bumps and dips in the streets and sidewalks.



With the number of trick-or-treaters increasing each year we ask that **PETS BE LEFT AT HOME**. Although its fun to dress them up and show them off it poses a safety concern as the streets become overcrowded and congested. Leaving them at home will ensure their safety as well as those in attendance. We thank you in advance for understanding and complying with this request.
