

Town of Clarkdale
PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING USE OF CDBG FUNDS

The **Town of Clarkdale** is expected to receive approximately **\$264,219.00** in FY14 federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Regional Account. The **Town of Clarkdale** may also intend to apply for up to \$300,000 in FY14 CDBG funds from the State Special Projects (SSP) account. CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight, or address urgent need. A public hearing will be held at **6:00pm** on **December 10, 2013** at Clark Memorial Clubhouse, Men's Lounge **19 N. Ninth St., Clarkdale** to gather citizen input on the use of the CDBG funds.

Sample CDBG projects are:

- 1) **Public infrastructure** (e.g., water, wastewater, drainage improvements);
- 2) **Community facilities** (e.g., halfway houses, senior centers, food banks);
- 3) **Housing** (e.g., owner occupied housing rehabilitation, utility connections on private property, rental housing rehabilitation);
- 4) **Public services** (e.g., emergency assistance, purchasing a van to transport persons with disabilities, services for homeless persons);
- 5) **Economic development** (e.g., a loan to a business for job creation, micro-enterprise development, acquisition of land for an existing business expansion).
