

## **Town of Clarkdale Public Hearing Regarding Use of CDBG Funds**

The Town of Clarkdale is expected to receive approximately \$321,357.00 in FY 2018 CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Regional Account (RA). CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. Based on citizen input as well as local and state planning objectives a potential project has been selected to be forwarded to the State of Arizona with a request for funding. A public hearing will be held at the Regular Town Council meeting at 6:00 P.M. on January 9, 2018 at the Men's Lounge Council Chambers, 19 N. Ninth St, Clarkdale, Arizona to discuss the potential projects. It is expected that the Town Council will select the final project at this hearing and adopt applicable resolutions. The potential CDBG projects are named and described as follows:

- **Town Hall ADA Improvements:** Complete Phase 2 of ADA Restroom Installations in the Clark Memorial Clubhouse (Design Completed under 2014 CDBG funding). Install ADA compliant access ramp on back deck of Men's Lounge at the Clark Memorial Clubhouse. Will serve approximately 763 disabled residents of Clarkdale, all (100%) of whom are considered low to moderate income.
- **Rincon Road Project:** Reconstruction of Rincon Road from Vista Lane to Rio Lane.
- **Centerville Road Project:** Road Improvements to Avenida Padilla, Avenida Macias, Avenida Guillermo, Calle Rosas and Calle Tomallo.
