### **Free Concert in Clarkdale Park**

Bring your dancin' shoes and be prepared to dance and bang your head to the music of Aces n Eights on Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, from 6-8 p.m. This concert is part of Clarkdale's free Concerts in the Park series.

Like the doors swinging open of an old saloon, Aces n Eights has everyone turning their heads to see who is coming through. A new band for our area but certainly no new talent. This 4 member band is really making a statement. Their style is unique only in the manner that they play a great variety of music ranging from Shania Twain to Judas Priest. Each of the members has brought their own flair to the stage. Martin Etcheverry would be considered the leader of the group, playing lead guitar and also adding vocals, he is considered their "blues man". Scott Core, their drummer, is the "metal freak", Marc Franquero, on the bass, is the "soul man" and Laurie Etcheverry, lead vocal and rhythm guitar, is the "rocker girl" but she can sing a country song to make your heart melt.

Each of these members brings such an electric variety that mixed together produce a sound like no other band in the area. Their influences and experiences vary greatly, but each member has devoted a large portion of their lives to music. Laurie quotes "the band has been together for a little over a year. We're still cutting our teeth but it's really coming together. When people hear us they say the great diversity is what makes us stand out from the rest". Their attitude is very positive and the electric variety is great. They know how to play to the crowd and suit their music to it. Come and check out the new guns in town, you're really going to like them.

So gather your friends, family, and lawn chairs for an evening of family fun. The park is located in the center of the town's historic district on Main Street, between 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Streets.
