New Signage for Traffic Control Installed on Main Street in Clarkdale

CLARKDALE, AZ (November 22, 2006) – On October 12, 2006 the Clarkdale Police Department held a Neighborhood meeting to address the traffic concerns on Main Street in Upper Clarkdale. Based on suggestions of citizens in attendance at the meeting, new stop signs and new street signs are being installed along Main Street between 11th and 16th Streets.

As of the first week in November there is a new sign at the intersection of 11th Street and Main Street that reads “Entering a Residential Area”. On Main Street at 13th Street there are temporary stop signs. Permanent stop signs at Main Street and 16th Street will soon be in place.

In addition to the increased signage on Main Street, temporary stop signs will be placed at the intersection of First North Street at 15th Street in an effort to slow traffic on First North Street. That effort will be repeated at a soon to be determined intersection on First South Street.
