### **Cadillac Angels to rock Clarkdale Concerts in the Park**

On Saturday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, Clarkdale Community Services/Parks & Recreation is proud to present **CADILLAC ANGELS**. They will perform 7-9 p.m. at the Clarkdale Town Park gazebo. This concert is FREE to the public.

**CADILLAC ANGELS** is one of the best rockabilly bands in the land. Although based in Arizona, the Cadillac Angels hail from Santa Barbara and have left their mark on the music scene since the early '80s. The band, formally known as the Roadhouse Rockers with front man and creative genius Tony Balbinot, energizes the crowd with a kind of music that has managed to survive 50 years of semi-obscurity and a few bursts of popularity. The roots, rockabilly, and surf-rock outfit recently released Two Blocks Off Main, their 15th recording.
