### **Clarkdale Concerts in the Park will feature 2 G's & a C Note**

On Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, Clarkdale Community Services/Parks & Recreation is proud to present **2 G's & a C NOTE** formerly Livas Martinez. They will perform 7-9 p.m. at the Clarkdale Town Park gazebo. This concert is sponsored by The Clarkdale Foundation and is FREE to the public.

Long-time Verde Valley residents, Chris Livas and Dave Martinez reconnected three years ago to form the acoustic duo Livas Martinez. This duo has now been joined by Kevin McQuaid to make up **2 G'S & a C NOTE**, a harmony based acoustic trio. They have over 50 years of musical experience which is evident in their act - performing their own blend of harmonies. Their show includes a mixture of classic rock from the likes of James Taylor, CSN, Cat Stevens, The Eagles and Elton John, just to name a few. Kevin adds a third voice, cello and percussion to Chris Livas on vocals, guitar and harmonica, and Dave Martinez on vocals and guitar. The trio performs at numerous venues throughout the Verde Valley.

The park is located in the center of the town's historic district on Main Street, between 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Streets. There is a playground for the kids to enjoy while the adults listen and dance to the music. Vendors will be on site. There is a 50/50 raffle which all proceeds benefit the Concerts in the Park.

Vending spaces are available and can be arranged by contacting Community Services at (928) 639-2460. Requirements have been updated to allow vendors to use self-contained generators that are rated at 68dB or less and are equipped with spark arrestors.
