### **Trotter's Wake Irish Band to perform in Clarkdale's Concerts in the Park**

Time to practice your Irish Jig! On Saturday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, Clarkdale Community Services/Parks & Recreation is proud to present **TROTTER'S WAKE IRISH BAND**. They will perform 7-9 p.m. at the Clarkdale Town Park gazebo. This concert is **FREE** to the public.

**TROTTERS WAKE IRISH BAND** is a five piece vocal acoustic band consisting of Drew Monasky - Acoustic guitar, mandolin, vocals, Bonnie Teplik – Fiddle, April Trinidad - Fiddle, Cyndy Gaughan - Bodhran (Irish hand drum), and Jennifer Caraway - Electric bass. Trotters Wake performs a mixture of Irish drinking songs, Irish and Celtic ballads, and traditional Irish tunes (jigs, reels, etc.). They are located in Glendale, Arizona (USA) and play in the Greater Phoenix Metropolitan area and throughout Arizona. They have more fun playing Irish music than should be legal, and they want listeners to experience the same thing. The park is located in the center of the town's historic district on Main Street, between 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Streets.
