1. The Contractor shall provide to the Town's Public Works Department a **Traffic Control Plan** in all cases; at least 24 hours in advance of any work in the right-a-way that necessitates any portion of street blockage. The Traffic Control Plan shall include a drawing of the street where the work zone will be located along with the nearest cross street noted as well. Street names, north arrows, type of traffic control devices, distances between, and location of excavation on the street shall also be noted.
2. A minimum of one lane must remain open at all times, unless an alternate reasonable route is approved in advance by the Public Works Director or Town Engineer where available for traffic. A certified Flagger is required to facilitate traffic flow safely through a construction zone, at the sole discretion of the Town. The contractor shall adhere to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) for all traffic control plans. Any equipment or other obstructions left on the road surface after sunset must be barricaded with lighted barricades. The Town Police Department and the Clarkdale Fire District must be notified for emergency routing.
